



EVALUATION ON ONLINE PLATFORMS IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHING AT SMP FITRA ABDI PALEMBANG

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to evaluate on online platforms in English language teaching at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang. The research focused on eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang of the 2023/2024 academic year, with the total of 31 students. The researchers using a descriptive qualitative research method that typically involves detailed data to provide a comprehensive understood of a phenomenon. And utilized the data collection techniques with a questionnaire, and interviews. Additionally, the results of the questionnaires showed 3305 of a total score of, indicated that students used online platforms in learned English. In conclusion showed that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang used the Duolingo app to learned English instead of used Hello Talk app and Beelinguapp.

1. PENDAHULUAN

Language is a method that is used to communicate with others. In addition to verbal language, people also communicate through body language, sign language and facial expressions. Language is foremost a means of communication, and communication almost always takes places within some sort of social context, language is a rule – based system of signs (Amberg & Vause, 2009: 2). And also, as states by Sweet (2024), language is the

expressions of ideas by means of speech– sounds combined into words, words are combined into sentences, and this elaboration answered to ideas into thoughts.

According to Kridalaksana and Kentjono (in Chaer, 2014:32) language is an arbitrary system of sound symbols used by members of social groups to cooperate, communicate and identify themselves. In short, the word "language" is a means of communication (Tarigan, 1987:22-23). Language universals refer to the general

characteristics of language that are found in all languages. The term language universals were first introduced by Chomsky (1966) in his grand theories said that the characteristics of language that are common to all languages include (a) every human being must have language, (b) all languages change, (c) there is no primitive language, every language has its own degree of complexity, (d) all languages have vowels and consonants, (e) all languages have a set of sounds that could combined into meaningful elements, and (f) in every language, the number of nasal vowels is always lower than the number of vowels without a nasal.

Language acquisition refers to the process by which individuals develop the ability to perceive, comprehend, and produce language. Theriana (2019) believe that, the teaching and learning process is the core of education. Education is a conscious effort to prepare students through guidance, teaching, or training activities for their future roles, because it basically takes students from a basis that does not understand anything towards changes in behaviour both intellectual moral or social so that they could live independently as individual social person.

Learning English could definitely enhance your opportunities to pursue further education in foreign countries. This language skill open doors to studied at international institutions and accessed a broader range of academic resources. By mastering English, we could have a significant impact on career development and success in the global workforce. As the predominant language of business, technology, and international communication, English proficiency can help you to connect with a broader network of professionals, access more job opportunities, and could navigate a variety of industries. Furthermore, by learning English we're invested in skills that could facilitate career growth, expand your professional horizons, and open doors to new opportunities.

The reason why students learn languages is crucial because motivation significantly impacts their achievements. Research in the field of language learned motivation often emphasizes several key motivational factors, such as: (a) intrinsic motivation, learned for personal satisfaction, interest, or enjoyment; (b) extrinsic motivation, learned for external rewards such as grades, career opportunities, or social recognition; (c)

2. LITERATURE REVIEW**The Definition of Online Platform**

"collaborative" or "gig" economy, and much more. Online platforms could include all of e-commerce. An online platform is defined as a digital service that facilitates interactions between two or more distinct but interdependent sets of users (whether firms or individual) who interact through the service via the internet ("OECD", 2019).

3. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION**Data from Questionnaire**

The result of the questionnaire was used as a primary data and also the interview as a secondary data. The question of the questionnaire consisted of 30 questions. This could explain the

- Question number 1: I love English courses.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 8, show that 1 student said "Strongly Agree" (3.22%), 1 student said "Agree" (3.22%), 5 students said "Neutral" (16.15%), 18 students said "Disagree" (58.06%), and 6 students said "Strongly Disagree" (19.35%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students

- Question number 10: I used other online platforms to learn English besides the ones mentioned above.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 10, show that 3 students said "Strongly Agree" (9.67%), 6 students said "Agree" (19.35%), 5 students said "Neutral" (16.15%), 9 students said "Disagree" (29.03%), and 8 students said "Strongly Disagree" (25.80%). From the

result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang never used the other online platforms to learning English.

- Question number 11: I think learning English used an online platform is easier to understood.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 11, show that 15 students said "Strongly Agree" (48.38%), 7 students said "Agree" (22.58%), 5 students said "Neutral" (16.15%), 3 students said "Disagree" (9.67%), and 1 student said "Strongly Disagree" (3.22%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang agree that used an online platform to learn English is easier to understood.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 12, show that 12 students said "Strongly Agree" (38.70%), 8 students

Results from the questionnaire for question number 14, show that 3 students said "Strongly Agree" (29.03%), 3 students said "Agree" (25.80%), 7 students said "Neutral" (22.60%), 8 students said "Disagree" (16.12%), and 10 students said "Strongly Disagree" (6.45%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang disagree with the statement said that learning English used an online platform is inefficient.

- Question number 15: I think that learning English through an online platform is easier.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 15, show that 9 students said "Strongly Agree" (29.05%), 14 students said "Agree" (45.16%), 6 students said "Neutral" (19.35%), 1 student said "Disagree" (3.22%), and 1 student said

Results from the questionnaire for question number 16, show that 2 students said "Strongly Agree" (6.45%), 5 students said "Agree" (16.12%), 3 students said "Neutral" (9.70%), 15 students said "Disagree" (48.38%), and 6 students said "Strongly Disagree" (19.35%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang agree that learning English used online platforms is not difficult.

- Question number 17: I believe that learning English through an online platform provided a better understood.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 17, show that 9 students

said "Strongly Agree" (29.03%), 12 students said "Agree" (38.70%), 6 students said "Neutral" (19.35%), 3 students said "Disagree" (9.67%), and 1 student said "Strongly Disagree" (3.25%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang agree that learning English using online platforms is could provide a better understood.

- Question number 18: I think it is difficult to learning English through an online platform.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 18, show that 3 students said "Strongly Agree" (9.67%), 5 students said "Agree" (16.15%), 8 students said "Neutral" (25.80%), 13 students said "Disagree" (41.93%), and 2 students said "Strongly Disagree" (6.45%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang found learning English using an online platform neither difficult nor easy / neutral.

From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang believe they could learn comfortably, with or without used an online platform.

- Question number 20: I am more comfortable learning English using an online platform.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 20, show that 5 students said "Strongly Agree" (16.15%), 6 students said "Agree" (19.32%), 11 students said "Neutral" (35.48%), 5 students said "Disagree" (16.15%), and 4 students said

"Strongly Disagree" (12.90%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang believe they could learn comfortably, with or without used an online platform.

- Question number 21: I usually found it harder to learn the subject matter on online platforms.

Results from the questionnaire for question number 21, show that 9 students said "Strongly Agree" (29.03%), 6 students said "Agree" (19.35%), 7 students said "Neutral" (22.60%), 6 students said "Disagree" (19.35%), and 3 students said "Strongly Disagree" (9.67%). From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang agree that learning the subject matter on online platforms is difficult.

- Question number 22: I usually found it easier to learn the subject matter on online platforms

Results from the questionnaire for question number 22, show that 5 students

From the result of the questionnaire, we could conclude that most eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang agree that an online platform is easy to use.

English instead of used HelloTalk app and Beelinguapp.

4. CONCLUSION

Based on the results that the researcher has collected and analysed by the questionnaires, and interviews. The result of the questionnaires showed that the total scores 3305. Likely, they used an online platform as directed by their teachers but are equally comfortable with traditional teaching methods. And it showed that most of them used the DuoLingo app to learning English instead of used HelloTalk app and Beelinguapp.

And based on the problem of the research about students' perception of online platforms, that showed most of the eighth – grade students at SMP Fitra Abdi Palembang agree that used an online platform to learning English is more efficient and could help them to improve their language learning skills.
